WHAT HAPPENED TO THE HURRICANE PANDEMIC THAT AL GORE AND THE UN HAVE BEEN CONTINUOUSLY PREDICTING *FOR THREE DECADES?*

In 1990, the UN issued its first emergency global warming alert, which warned that unless urgent action was taken, near-term climate collapse was imminent. Along with a long list of other terrifying predictions, the report predicted that the frequency of catastrophic hurricanes would increase exponentially without immediate enactment of massive carbon consumption taxes. So what happened? The dire forecasts proved embarrassingly wrong. Even though CO2 rose to record levels with each passing year, there [has not been](#) a single Category 3 or stronger hurricane to hit the U.S. since 2005. That's nine years and counting, hardly a pandemic by any measure.
