

# Mother Nature 1, Climate Fear Industry 0

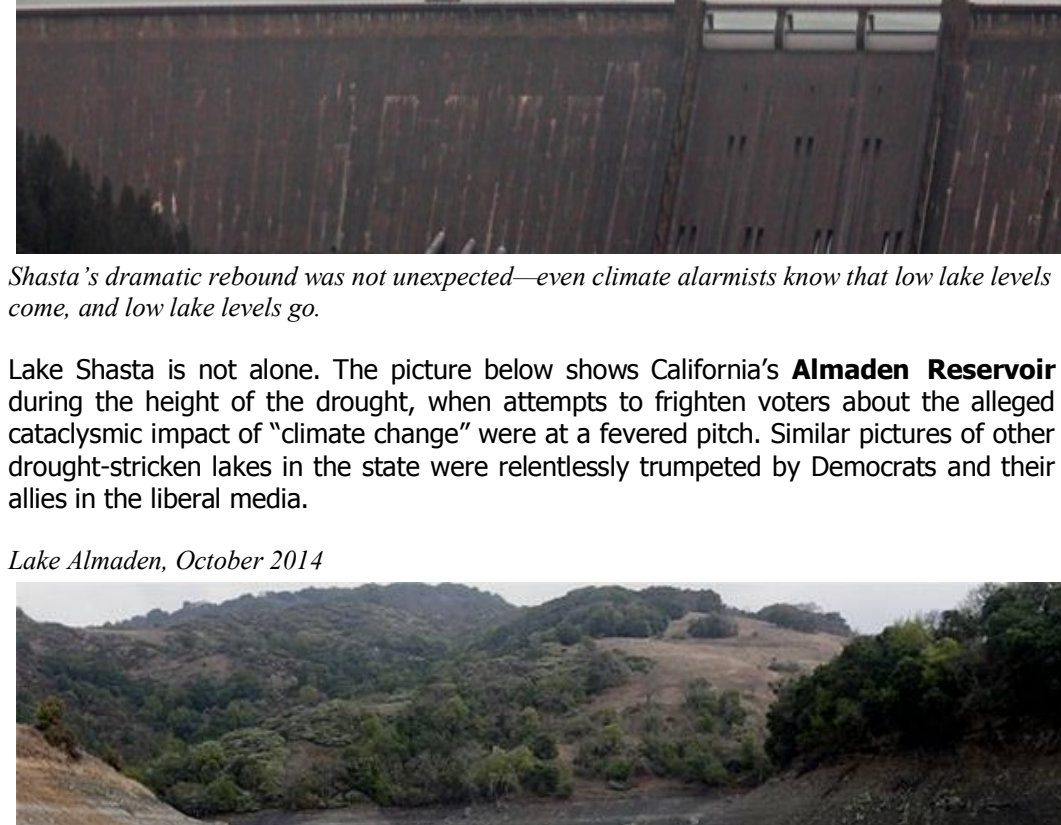
*Plentiful rainfall returns to drought-stricken California.*

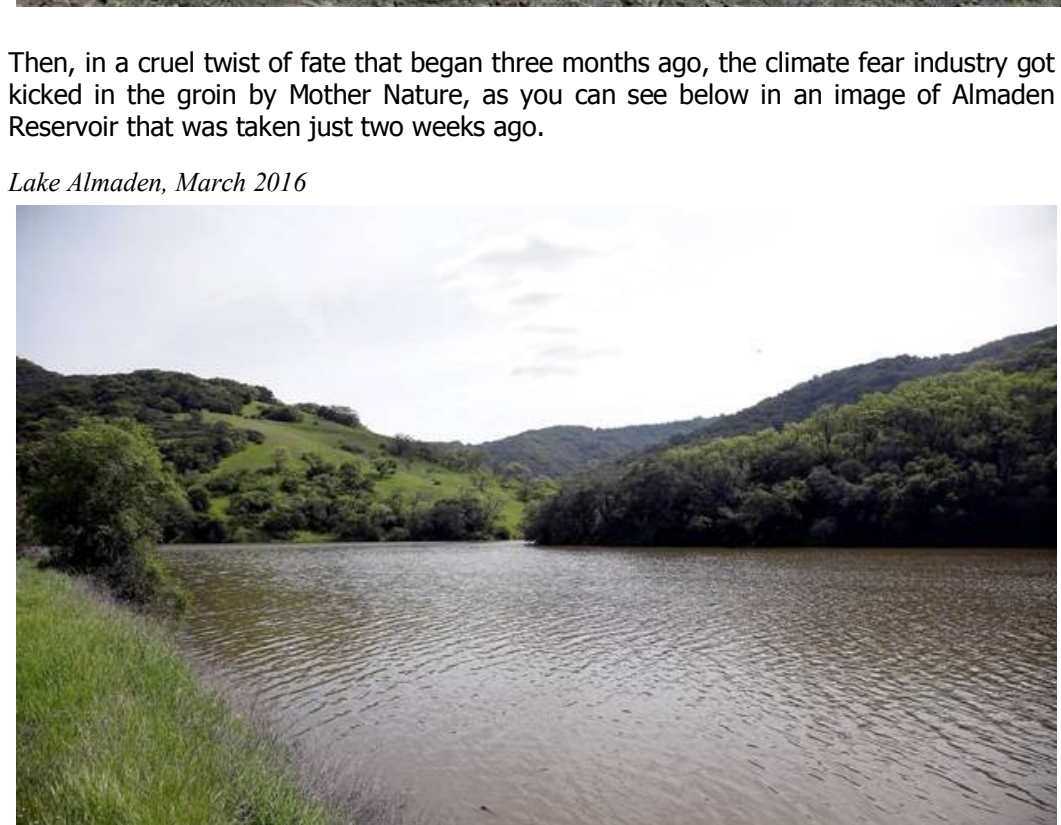
*Lake Shasta, March 2016*



*Shasta's dramatic rebound was not unexpected—even climate alarmists know that low lake levels come, and low lake levels go.*

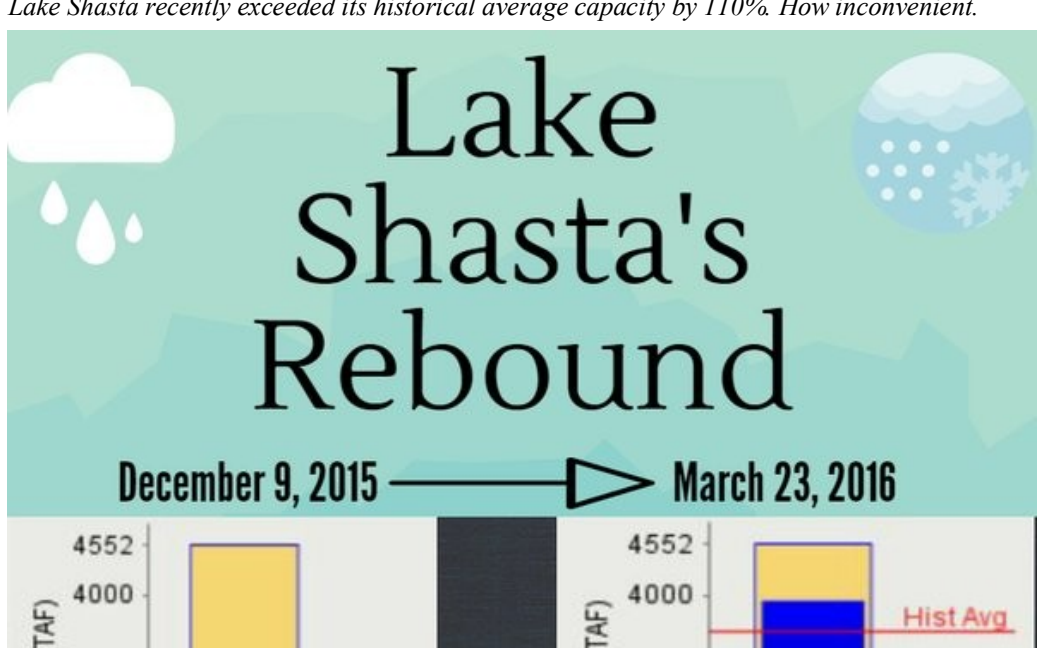
