The Crispus Attucks Helping Hand Inner City Scholarship Program

A proposed privately funded scholarship program to help minority kids from low-income families get a quality education

Inner city kids deserve better than this:

In 2010-2011, public schools in the nation's capitol spent \$29,345 per pupil—nearly \$600,000 per classroom of 20 students—yet DC students finished dead last in a national proficiency test in math and reading.

According to an investigation by *Project Baltimore*, 13 of the city's 39 high schools had zero students who tested proficient in math. Of the 3,840 pupils in the remaining 26 high schools, only 14 tested proficient in math, less than one-third of one percent.

According to the Department of Education's 2015 National Assessment of Educational Proficiency, 96% of 8th graders in Detroit's public schools tested not proficient in math, and 93% tested not proficient in reading.
